#### Curriculum

- Tenney School works with students with diverse academic abilities. Students are placed in courses based on how they perform on the Stanford Achievement Test. Students performing below grade level will be placed in courses labeled as Mod (Modified) or ELL (English Language Learner). Students performing above grade level will be in courses labeled H (for Honors).
- The following courses are currently available at the Advanced Placement level:
  - o AP English III
  - o AP English IV
  - AP Environmental Science
  - AP Precalculus
  - o AP Calculus
  - AP Statistics
  - o AP Human Geography
  - AP World History
- Approximately 30% of juniors and seniors are enrolled in one or more AP classes.
- Students at Tenney complete the Texas Education Agency Distinguished Level of Achievement (26 credits or more) program.
